

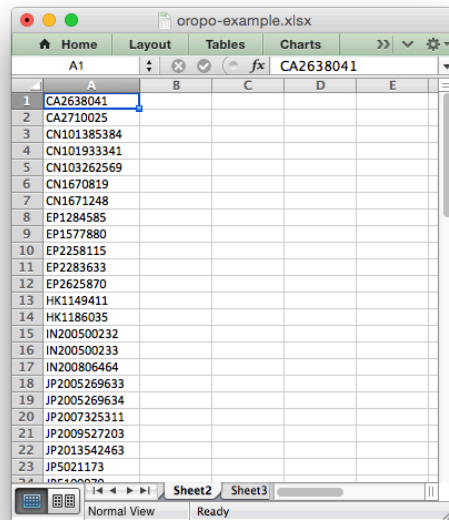
Sending data to ORoPO

Uploads to ORoPO should be made as text, TSV or CSV files of patent / application publication numbers, with one line per patent number. It can include the kind code, if known, but it's not essential.

If you have your patent numbers in an Excel spreadsheet in the format shown to the right then it's easy to export.

The format is one patent per line, with country code (or EP, WO etc. pseudo-codes) and patent number, e.g.

Kind codes are optional for countries where they're not required, and we can also accept other formats. Please contact us at data@oropo.net if you have any questions.

Once the patent numbers are in your spreadsheet in an appropriate form, use the Save As... menu option to export the data as CSV.

The saved CSV file can then be sent to OPoPO via an email to data@oropo.net.

When we receive the data, we will do some checking to ensure that there are the correct number of digits, and looking for common errors.
